## SPRING/SUMMER EDITION

The Village of Chittenango is located approximately 20 miles east of Syracuse, New York, in Central New York and was founded in 1812. The community population is 5,081 and approximately 2.2 square miles in area. The Village is substantially residential in nature with some light industry and a commercial area that runs through the center. To the south of the Village is Chittenango Falls State Park. Chittenango Creek runs through the center of the community. Chittenango translates "where the water runs north". Chittenango is best known for being the birthplace of L. Frank Baum, author of the Wizard of Oz and many other written works. Annually, the first weekend in June, the Village is host to OzStravaganza which celebrates our famous hometown author. The family-oriented event includes visiting actors, authors, parade, food, family fun, and music. We are also home to the Chittenango Landing Canal Boat Museum on the Erie Canal which hosts many events and programs teaching the history of the Erie Canal.

Leaves must be placed in containers during your spring/summer cleanup

**Your help is needed! Please do not flush disposable wipes, baby wipes, or cleaning wipes into the sanitary sewer system as these wipes do not decompose and are causing issues with the Village's sewer lift stations. Thanks for your help and cooperation!**

Grass clippings must be containerized  
Keep trash and recycling containers separated  
Use SHARP safe containers for used needles, when full and sealed take to County Transfer Station for disposal.  
Keep each trash container weight under 50 lbs.  
**Do not use black bags for trash or recycling**  
Be sure to secure trash and recycling on windy days  
Only four trash containers allowed per property on each pickup day.

The Village Public Work Department does pick up large items for various fees. A form listing acceptable items along with the appropriate fee can be completed at the Clerk's Office. Once the fee has been paid (cash or check), the items will be picked up on the next regular trash pickup day for your area. No refunds if item(s) are picked up by someone else. Forms are available at [chittenango.org](http://chittenango.org) or the Clerk's Office.

Please note that on Monday May 27 (Memorial Day observed) and September 2, 2019 brush pickup will be delayed and will be picked up during the week of the holiday. **Trash/recycle pickup scheduled for Thursday July 4 will be moved to Friday, July 5. Friday July 5 pickup will be moved to Monday, July 8, 2019.**

## CHITTENANGO POLICE DEPARTMENT

In cooperation with BRIDGES, the Chittenango Police Department has placed a drug disposal kiosk at the Chittenango Village Hall. Its purpose is to ensure the prevention of prescription drug abuse and protect the environment with safe disposal of medications. Medications can be dropped in the secure kiosk Monday-Friday from 8:30-4:30. The kiosk is open to the public; it is not open to medical offices, hospitals or pharmacies. Accepted items include prescriptions medications, patches, liquids, ointments, lotions and samples, over the counter medications, veterinary medications and vitamins. All items must be transported by the individual to whom the prescription was made and must remain in the correctly labeled container. **Items not accepted are thermometers, aerosol sprays, inhalers & hydrogen peroxide and medical waste.** Sharps (syringes) are not accepted at the kiosk. Sharps containers can be obtained free of charge at your local pharmacy or County Landfill. If you have questions, please contact BRIDGES at 315-697-3947.

## NYSDEC BURN BAN

No open burning is permitted in the Village of Chittenango from March 16-May 14, 2019. Burning of limbs and branches is prohibited. Burning of leaf piles is prohibited in all cases at all times. Burning of household trash is prohibited in all cases at all times. Camp fires and small cooking fires size shall not exceed 4 feet wide and less than 3 feet high. ## VILLAGE CLERK'S OFFICE NEWS

Village real property tax collection begins June 3, 2019 at the Village Clerk's Office during the hours of 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please note that any unpaid OCWA water bills will be shown as a relevy on your tax bill, as well as, any unpaid Village sewer billings, lawn mowing charges or building placarding charges. They will be itemized on the tax bill. Village taxes can be paid with cash or check through July 2, 2019 without penalty. Beginning July 3, a 5% penalty will be added to the tax amount, each month the bill remains unpaid, an additional 1% penalty will be added. The Village is required to send out a second notice by August 16 to property owners whose Village tax bill has not been paid for a fee of \$2. Any unpaid taxes by October 1, 2019 will be sent to Madison County Treasurer's Office for collection. Questions about unpaid taxes sent to the County can be directed to the Madison County Treasurer's Office 315-366-2371. Any amounts that remain unpaid will be added to the State, Town, and County tax bill in January. Quarterly sewer bills will be sent out in July, October, January and April. The October billing will reflect any outside water usage for those residents that use a separate outdoor water meter. The minimum quarterly bill will be \$35. The billing rate is being raised to \$6.25 per 1,000 gallons of water used. The Village fiscal year is June 1 through May 31.

The Village Offices will be closed on May 27, July 4, September 2, and October 14, 2019.

**ATTENTION DOG OWNERS/WALKERS: Dog waste cleanup is a real concern in our Village.**

The Village has provided dog waste disposal stations in various parks and business areas throughout the Village in an effort to help residents and visitors with cleanup and disposal of pet waste. PLEASE if you walk your dogs anywhere in the Village, clean up and dispose of their waste properly so everyone can enjoy the parks, trails, roadways, and sidewalks. It is also the Law. Thank you!



## VILLAGE PARKS AND TRAILS

**Chittenango Creek Walk and Neighborhood Trail Committee** Work continues on expansion of the Village trail system. A bridge dedication for the new footbridge at the Erie Canal is planned for June 7. Discussions are continuing on expansion of the trail from Tuscarora Road to the Canal. The Trail Committee meets at the Chittenango Village Hall on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of the month at 7 p.m. You are welcome to come to these meetings. The Village has installed a new playground system in Kirschenheiter Park. There are plans underway for some additional equipment to be added to this system this year.

## VILLAGE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICE

The Village of Chittenango Code Enforcement Officer is ready to help you with your spring/summer building projects. Permits are required for pools, fences, decks and sheds. Check with the Codes Office at 315-687-5143 before beginning any construction to see if a permit is required. Office hours- 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Mon-Fri. **Swimming pools** include in-ground, above-ground, and on-ground pools, indoor pools, hot tubs, spas, and fixed- in- place wading pools. A pool which contains a depth of 24" of water is a swimming pool. A **permit is required**. A reminder: It is unlawful for property owners within the Village to store or deposit junked or **abandoned motor vehicles or unlicensed motor vehicles**, licensed but not bearing a current valid certificate of inspection, even with coverings, on any private property within the Village. For more info or questions, contact the Code Office. **Digging?** Call Dig Safe NY (8u) to have any underground utilities marked. Please note: if your project is located in the commercial area of the Village, it might require review by either the Planning or Zoning Board in relation to the adopted Commercial Design Guidelines and Overlay District for the Village **before any work begins**.

## VILLAGE COURT

The Village Court office is open 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Court dates are the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday each month. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday court begins at 5:30 p.m. and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday court begins at 1:15 p.m. To reach the Court office directly, call 315-687-3937. The Village Justice is John Button and the Acting Village Justice is Christina Sudol.
