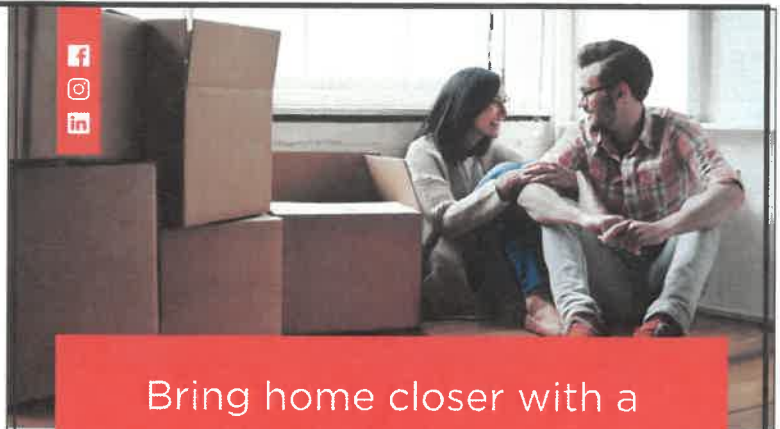

The Village of Chittenango is located approximately 20 miles east of Syracuse, New York, which is in Central New York and was founded in 1812. The community population is 5,081 and is approximately 2.2 square miles in area. The Village is substantially residential in nature with some light industry and a commercial area that runs through the center. To the south of the Village is Chittenango Falls State Park. Chittenango Creek runs through the center of the community. Chittenango means "where the water runs north". Chittenango is best known for being the birthplace of L. Frank Baum, author of the Wizard of Oz and many other written works. Annually, the first weekend in June, the Village is host to OzStravaganza which celebrates our famous hometown author. The family-oriented event includes visiting actors, authors, parade, food, family fun, and music.

VILLAGE DPW

Trash collection - Do not use black bags for trash or recycling



Keep trash and recycling separate
Recycle & trash containers must be marked correctly
Use SHARP safe containers for used needles
Keep trash container size to 36 gallons AND
weight under 50 lbs.

Be sure to secure trash and recycling on windy days
Only four trash containers allowed per property

Outside water usage meters will be read by the DPW staff the week of September 9-13. Please place your separate outside-use meter on your front porch or near your front door for our reader to record the usage. Thank you! Credit for this reading will be reflected in your quarterly October 2019 Village sewer bill.

It's still summer, but soon school will begin and leaves will begin to fall. Some hints for

Leaves- DO put leaves in wind rows - **no** large piles

DO NOT mix brush with leaves

DO NOT put leaves in bags or containers

DO NOT put leaves in the road or drain outlets

Extra trash pickup service. Forms available online or at Clerk's Office. Payment (cash or check) for extra trash must be made prior to pick up. Pick up is regular trash collection day. **Watch website for changes in pick up due to holidays.**

Once leaf collection begins, the crew will cover the entire Village with the leaf vacuum, and then repeat the cycle to collect as many leaves as possible before snow fall. Please be patient- it is a long process when the leaves all begin to come down!

CHITTENANGO ARTISAN & FARMER'S MARKET, CLASSIC CAR & CONCERT SERIES

Tuesdays at Dr. West Park from 5-8 p.m. there is an Artisan/Farmer's Market, Car Show and Concert. Come join us and be part of the fun community atmosphere! Get some fresh fruits, vegetables honey, maple syrup, and other tasty treats, as well as, handmade, homemade crafts; soaps, wood products, crocheted, re-purposed treasures! Something for everyone. The Market includes music (live bands) through the end of August. Classic cars are on display (bring yours to share and show off!) and the Rotary Chuck Wagon, a taco truck, meatball vendor, pizza vendor and ice cream food vendor, artisans, and vendors, are also a part of the Market. DRUG DISPOSAL KIOSK

In cooperation with BRIDGES, the Chittenango Police Department has a drug disposal kiosk located at the Chittenango Village Hall. Its purpose is to ensure the prevention of prescription drug abuse and protect the environment with safe disposal of medications. Medications can be dropped off Monday-Friday from 8:30-4:30. The kiosk is open to the public; it is not open to medical offices, hospitals or pharmacies. Accepted items include prescriptions medications, patches, liquids, ointments, lotions and samples, over the counter medications, veterinary medications and vitamins. **Items NOT accepted are thermometers, aerosol sprays, inhalers & hydrogen peroxide, medical waste and Sharps (syringes).** Sharps containers can be obtained free of charge at your local pharmacy. VILLAGE SKATEBOARD PARK

The Village's skateboard park will be open, generally on a daily basis weather permitting from 1-5 p.m. until school begins and then on a reduced schedule.

VILLAGE CLERK'S OFFICE

The Village Clerk's Office hours are 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Village Tax Collector is required to send out a second notice by August 16 to property owners whose Village tax bill has not been paid by that date for a fee of \$2. Any unpaid Village taxes by September 30, 2019 will be sent to Madison County for collection. Any amounts that remain unpaid will be added to your State, Town, and County tax bill in January 2020. The Village Offices will be closed on September 2- Labor Day, October 14-Columbus Day, and November 11-Veteran's Day. There are notary services available. Vendors/solicitors intending to go door to door through the Village are required to obtain a permit from the Clerk's office. There is a form and fee for the permit. If someone comes to your door to sell a product or service, check to be certain they have a badge from the Village, giving them permission to solicit. If they don't have the required badge, contact the Police Department right away. Community Sign Board applications are available online at chittenango.org or the Clerk's Office for the digital sign board. The rules for the sign are included on the application. VILLAGE PARKS AND TRAILS

Chittenango Creek Walk and Neighborhood Trail Committee - Come and enjoy the trail system and natural beauty of the great outdoors right here in our Village! There is a link on the Village website (chittenango.org) where you can obtain a map and brochure about the Village's trail system. The Village is continuing to work on the development of Phase III of the Creekwalk which is planned to connect the Erie Canal to Tuscarora Road along Chittenango Creek. An 8 ft pedestrian footbridge over the Erie Canal from the Canal path has been installed. The Village has also approved a Madison Monday Mile project that will utilize a portion of the Creek walk and Village streets and encourages a walking program to encourage healthy lifestyle. New playground equipment has been installed at Kirschenheiter Park with a new section added this summer. VILLAGE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICE

The Village of Chittenango Code Enforcement Office is ready to help you with your summer/fall building projects. Permits are required for fences, decks, additions, renovations, and sheds. The Code also includes regulations for junked or abandoned motor vehicles -Chapter 94. If you have questions about zoning or permits, please contact our Codes Office at 315-687-5143. Please visit chittenango.org to download various permit applications and forms. The Village Code book and Village Comprehensive Plan also have a link on the website under the Code Enforcement tab.

Please be aware that the Village Code allows for two dogs per residence. The Village recently adopted legislation in regards to harboring hens (chickens). Please check the website.

√√√ **The Village has Codes relating to Dog Control.** Per Chapter 69 -10 A- "Any person owning, harboring or in charge of any dog which soils, defiles, defecates upon or commits any nuisance upon any common thoroughfare, sidewalk, passage, bypath, play area, park or place where people congregate or walk, or upon any public property whatsoever, or upon any private property without the permission of the owner of the property, in violation of §69-7B herein immediately remove all feces deposited by any dog, by means of any sanitary method approved by the local health authority." 2018 RABIES VACCINATION CLINICS

Madison County Department of Health has set up a calendar of rabies vaccination clinics throughout the County for 2019. All dogs, cats and ferrets are required to be vaccinated by 4 months of age; a second vaccination must be given within one year of the first, and actively immunized against rabies thereafter.
